

Membership.

Full Membership. All serving, ex-serving Warrant Officers, Chief Petty Officers of the Communications and Electronic Warfare sub-branch of the Operations or Warfare Branch and equivalent Submarine specialisation's; Communication Technicians. Serving and retired Officers who were promoted from Warrant Officer or Chief Petty Officer of any of the above specialisations and equivalent ranks of the Royal Marines are eligible for Full Membership.

Associate Membership. All serving and ex-serving Petty Officers and Royal Naval Reserve Warrant Officers, Chief Petty Officers and Petty Officers of the specialisation's mentioned above are eligible for Associate Membership. Any former communication rating or Wren not eligible under the rules above but considers he or she has strong grounds may apply for Associate Membership. Warrant Officers, Staff Sergeants and Sergeants of the Royal Signals who are serving in HMS Collingwood or who have served in either HMS Collingwood or HMS Mercury and serving and retired Officers who were promoted from those ranks, may apply for Associate Membership. The Committee shall decide eligibility for Associate Membership on individual merit

Proof of Service. Due to the raising of security issues it is now deemed necessary to ask potential members to include within their application some form of "Proof of Service", ie copy of discharge note, SC etc.
