Dear xxxxx,

I am a constituent and also a supporter of HMS President 1918, the last of 3 remaining WW1 ships and the only remaining Q ship submarine hunter. She is nearly 100 years old and needs refurbishment or will be scrapped and very surprisingly was refused lottery funding and a charity Libor grant which was for military related charities this year despite huge parliamentary and public support. I was very concerned when I heard she is now likely to be scrapped as being a supporter I know the charity are nearly out of funds. This is even more surprising especially with all the growing media interest and the BBC support. The ship has her 100th birthday in 2018 when the nation and veterans celebrate the WW1 Centenary which was due to include a Royal relaunch of her in Central London!

I hope you will therefore support the ship and ask the government to find the money somewhere to save her and support Dr Julian Lewis and his colleagues.
